**CSC 2010 MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL STATEMENT**

The Board of Directors of the Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC) has established the dues for 2010 in accordance with the club's By-Laws. Dues for 2010 are \$250 for Associate Members and \$450 for Regular Members. Some fees have changed. The State of Texas also requires that CSC collect a tax of 8.25% on dues and fees. The tax does not apply to United States Sailing Association membership dues. Payment may be your check or money order (*payable to the Corinthian Sailing Club*). No cash or third party checks please. Returned check charges will be billed to any members responsible for such charges.

**CSC bylaws require a minimum annual service requirement for each member. Details are on the reverse side of this notice. Please check the box below stating you have performed such service in 2009, or remit the fee of \$100.**

### Minimum Service Requirement

A bylaws addition, see below, was passed at the 2004 annual meeting to encourage members' involvement in club activities, such as helping with spruce up day, special club regattas or social events. The change defines a minimum service requirement for each regular and associate member, which was set at 8 hours for 2004. This requirement may be fulfilled by the member or the member's spouse or dependents. A fee, which was set at \$100, may be paid in lieu of performing the service. Each member will be asked to state that they fulfilled the 2009 service requirement, or remit the \$100 fee, with their 2010 membership renewal.

The board established the 2009 service requirement at 8 hours, or a fee of \$100 in lieu of performing the service.

The service requirement may be fulfilled by participation in any of the following activities:

- Helping with club sponsored workdays, shoreline cleanup or improvement projects;
- Assisting in a club sponsored sailing education program;
- Serving on race committee duty for club sponsored regattas;
- Helping with club sponsored social events;
- Being a member of Board of Directors committee as defined in Article VI; or
- Completing other activities approved by a member of the Board of Directors.

### Corinthian Sailing Club By-Laws *(Excerpt)*

#### ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

##### SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS.

(d) Each member shall be required to contribute a minimum level of service to the club each year. Documentation of the completed service shall be required as part of the annual membership renewal process. Failure to complete this provision will subject the member to a fee to be remitted in addition to their annual dues. The minimum service requirement and fee for non-compliance will be fixed by the Board of Directors and included as part of the annual membership renewal package. This requirement may be fulfilled by participation in any of the following activities

- (1) Helping with club sponsored workdays, shoreline cleanup or improvement projects.
  - (2) Assisting in a club sponsored sailing education program.
  - (3) Serving on race committee duty for club sponsored regattas.
  - (4) Helping with club sponsored social events.
  - (5) Being a member of Board of Director committee as defined in Article VI.
  - (6) Completing other activities approved by a member of the Board of Directors.
