



CSC Sunday Racing Series Notice of Race

Posted 1/13/2018 and remains in effect until revised by CSC Board.

1. Organizing Authority

The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Sailing Club, 441 East Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218.

2. Rules

The series will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* including the prescriptions of US Sailing Association. The one design class rules will apply as managed by the local one design fleets.

3. Entries

Skippers of boats regularly engaging in racing shall be members in good standing of the Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC) or White Rock Boat Club (WRBC). Guests of members and members of recognized yacht clubs are welcome to participate on singular occasions.

There are no entry forms or entry fees.

4. Boats / Classes

The following classes may race in the series: Corinthian (C), Flying Scot (FS), Snipe (S), Laser (L), and a Handicap Fleet (H). Other one design classes may race by petitioning the Race Committee for a start.

5. Schedule

Two races are scheduled to be held on Sundays and fleets will serve as Race Committee (RC) per the calendar published at www.cscsailing.org. Provided the RC Guidelines are met, a fleet may also race on their duty day. The first race warning signal is at 1330 hours. The second race will be as announced by the Race Committee.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions are online on the CSC website.

7. Racing Area

Racing area will be the waters of White Rock Lake.

8. Courses

Courses will be drop mark windward-leeward and triangle combinations described in the SI's.

9. Scoring

The finishing positions will be posted on the SCS bulletin board. Scoring will be managed by the one design fleets except that a fleet may not alter or delete a boats finishing position, which could include the results of a protest or a Rule 69 hearing.

10. Prizes

End of series prizes maybe awarded by and at the discretion of each fleet.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.
