Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC) is the Organizing Authority and Host for its annual CSC Laser Regatta being held, September 11-12, 2010. This is a two-day event for Lasers and Laser Radials. This regatta combines great racing, and a good dinner. We look forward to seeing you on power-boat free White Rock Lake for this regatta!

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012 (herein after "RRS"), and the International Laser Class Association Rules.

ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all Laser and Laser Radial boats.

REGISTRATION

Complete the online entry form at www.cscsailing.org or complete the attached entry form and submit in person at check-in. Registration fees must be paid at check-in.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is \$30.00 per entry for Lasers and Laser Radials. There is no early registration discount or late registration charge for this regatta. Registrants have the option of paying entry fees' by check or cash. Make checks payable to Corinthian Sailing Club. All fees must be paid in-person at skipper check-in to be a recognized entrant.

MEALS

Meals for the competitors are included in the entry fee. Additional meals packages will be \$20.00 per person. Meals included in the entry fee or meal packages consist of breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday and breakfast and lunch on Sunday.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available for official entrants during late registration and skipper check-in on September 11, 2009 at the Corinthian Sailing Club's clubhouse.

RACE FORMAT

Courses will be windward/leeward, triangle, Olympic or variations of such. It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up to eight (8) races over the two day regatta schedule. One race shall constitute a regatta.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System as specified in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that the lowest score will be excluded only if more than five races are sailed. This modifies RRS A2.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Standard Rig: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Radial Rig: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Corinthian Sailing Club is located within the Dallas Parks Department White Rock Lake Park. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the park.

Foot protection is required while on the CSC piers.
