## NOTICE OF RACE

The Championships regatta will be held on Sunday, October 14, 2012 on White Rock Lake.

The regatta is a Portsmouth event.

### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), each participating boat's Official Class Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. Entry Criteria

Skippers (Helmsmen) must be members of the Corinthian Sailing Club or White Rock Boat Club. This regatta is open to all classes that participate in regular Sunday, Wednesday, or Saturday racing organized by the Corinthian Sailing Club or the White Rock Boat Club. Racing classes include Butterfly, Corinthian, Sunfish, Snipe, Laser, Laser Radial, V-15 and Flying Scot. The regatta is a Portsmouth event.

### 3. Regatta Plan.

The White Rock Lake Championship and Maurice Martin Championship is a one-day regatta with three races scheduled.

### 4. Entry Fee

There is no entry fee for this regatta.

### 5. Schedule

- Registration will run from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM in the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse.
- Skippers' meeting will be at 11:00 AM on the dock outside the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse.
- Warning Signal for the First Race will be at 12:00 noon.
- Lunch will be served at the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse after the first or second race at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- Refreshments provided and awards given after the races at the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse.

### 6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available online and at registration on October 14, 2012 at the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse.

### 7. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System as specified in Appendix A of the RRS will apply. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

## **8. Courses**

The courses to be sailed will be those specified in the Corinthian Sailing Club Sunday Joint Race Program Sailing Instructions.

## **9. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the helmsmen and crews for the top 3 places. The White Rock Lake Championship Trophy will be awarded. The Maurice Martin Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the top CSC helmsman at the Corinthian Sailing Club Annual Banquet on November 9, 2012 at the Park Cities Club.
