Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (OA) cordially invites you to an open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keel Boats. The event is supporting the "Friends of White Rock Lake".

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Entry: Registration may be completed on line at CSCsailing.org. Late registration may be completed at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Sailing Instructions will be available on line and at check in.

Classes: Three boats of any one design will race as a class. Boats that do not form a one design class will be assigned to a Portsmouth handicap class.

Fees: Double handed boats advance, on-line (RegattaTech)\$60.00
Double handed boats, Sat. morning April 29\$75.00
NOTE; Includes Corinthians

Single handed boats advance, on-line (RegattaTech).....\$25.00
Single handed boats, Sat. morning April 29\$35.00
NOTE; Includes Optimist

Fees include one T-shirt, Saturday lunch, happy hour, Past Commodore's Dinner and Sunday lunch. Extra meals and T-shirts may be purchased at registration.

Courses: Two or three courses may be used. On the larger double handed course 5 races will be scheduled. On the single handed course 7 or more races will be scheduled.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta.

Boat Storage: Temporary boat storage may be arranged by contacting Forest Atkins at race@cscsailing.org

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top 2 finishers in each class. If the class has 5 or more entries, the top 3 finishers will be awarded. In addition, each prize winner will have their name and place inscribed on the Commodore's Cup Trophy which will be permanently displayed in the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse.
