2017 STATE FAIR REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

The State Fair Regatta will be held on Sat., October 7, 2017 on White Rock Lake, Dallas, Texas and sponsored by the Corinthian Sailing Club, 441 East Lawther Dr., Dallas, Texas 75218.

- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (“RRS”) and by Sailing Instructions provided upon registration.
- Entries:** The regatta is open to all centerboard boats having a Portsmouth Handicap Rating and to Corinthian class sailboats.
- Regatta Plan:** The State Fair Regatta is a one-day regatta with three races scheduled. Three or more boats of the same Class will constitute a fleet and race against each other as a One Design Class. Classes with fewer than three boats will be grouped together to form a Portsmouth Class.
- Entry Fees:** Registration fees are \$40 per boat for boats with a skipper and a crew. The registration fee for a single handed boat is \$20. These fees include lunch and post race snacks and refreshments. Extra lunch tickets can be purchased for \$10 per ticket.
- Schedule:** Registration will run from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM in the Clubhouse. Breakfast, coffee and donuts will be provided.
Skippers’ meeting will be at 9:45 AM on the dock outside the Clubhouse.
First Race at 10:30 AM.
Three races are scheduled for the Regatta.
Lunch will be served at the clubhouse after the first or second race at the discretion of the Race Committee.
Snack-refreshments will be provided and awards given after the races at the clubhouse.
- Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on October 7, 2017 at the clubhouse, and may be available on the CSC website prior to the event.
- Scoring:** The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will be used modified so that all races will count. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- Courses:** The courses to be sailed will be those specified in the Corinthian Sailing Club Sunday Joint Race Program Sailing Instructions.
- Prizes:** Prizes will be given to the top finishers in each class, depending on the number of boats registered.
- Disclaimer of Liability** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
