The Southwest District Championship will be sailed in conjunction with the Open House Regatta this year. To sail (be scored) in the districts, the skipper must be a member of a fleet in the Southwest District and a member of the Flying Scot Sailing Association (FSSA). If you are not an FSSA member and do not choose to join at this time, you may still sail in the Open House Regatta and be eligible for regatta prizes, but you will not scored in the district championship. Changes to the Notice of Race are in italics.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form and making the required payment prior to midnight CDT Monday, Oct 11th.

Entrants shall select to sail in the Championship, Challenger or Non-Spinnaker Fleet when registering, except that the winner of the Challenger Division in the last two years must sail in the Championship Division.

To be eligible to participate in the Southwest District Championship, the skipper must be a member of a fleet in the Southwest District and a member in good standing of the Flying Scot Sailing Association.

SCORING

Five (5) races are planned. One race shall be completed to constitute a regatta. The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will be used except that no scores will be excluded.

The Championship, Challenger and Non-spinnaker Fleets will each be scored independently. *All boats will be scored for Open House Regatta. Only eligible boats will be scored in the district championship.*

PRIZES

Open House Regatta prizes will be awarded in all three fleets based on number of participants in each fleet. The winner of the Southwest District Championship will receive the district championship trophy.
